Method of Payment: Cash, check, credit card or money order

Refunds at the End of the Year

The computer software, used by school food service at each school, tracks meal payments and deductions for the purchase of meals or extra food items. Cash payments and check numbers are recorded. At the end of the school year, **parents may receive a refund of unused money from the students account by requesting it, in writing, from the cafeteria manager prior to the last day of school.** No refunds will be given after June 30, 2009.

Make check payable to: EBRP School Food Service

Write one check per child: In memo section of the check, write the student's name and point of service LUNCH NUMBER, if known.

Meal Payments Due: ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH OR WEEK

- If you pay for meals, it is recommended that you send August's payment on the first day of school.
- Prepayment for meals by the month, week or year is recommended. **NO CHARGES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Daily cash payments may be accepted during meal service; however, students spend less time in line if meals are prepaid. You can maximize the time your child has to eat lunch by taking care of meal payments at the beginning of the month or week rather than in the lunch line.

PARENTS OF ELEMENTARY STUDENTS: Place **cash payments** in a **sealed envelope** that is labeled with the student's name, purpose for which money is intended, and amount of **cash** sent.

An application for school meal benefits will be mailed home to parents approximately one week prior the opening of school. Parents are to fill out ONE APPLICATION PER FAMILY. The completed application form may be returned to the EBRP School Food Service Office, 3000 N. Sherwood Forest Drive, Baton Rouge, LA 70814 before school begins OR return ONE application to the cafeteria manager at the school where your youngest child is enrolled. Those students who received free or reduced price benefits last year will begin the new school year on the same status. However, by September 19, 2008 a new application must be submitted and processed for the 2008-2009 school year in order for meal benefits to continue.
